What is Aquatic Therapy?

- A physical therapy procedure completed in a warm water environment

Who is Aquatic Therapy for?

- Weight-bearing restricted clients
- Pain with any functional activities
- Patients with edema
- Comorbidities (obesity, joint discomfort, etc.)
- And many more!

What do I need to provide prior to starting Aquatic Therapy?

- Referral from your doctor

- Insurance Information

What you should bring to each appointment

- Swimsuit or clothes you are comfortable wearing in the pool
- Aquatic shoes (optional)
- Water bottle (optional)

Evaluation Day Process (First appointment)

- Appointment scheduled for 90 minutes
- Arrive 10-15 minutes prior to appointment start time to fill out paperwork
- First half of the appointment is on land, Second half in water

Treatment Day Process

- Appointments following evaluation are 45 minutes each
~This does not include change time; be sure to arrive about 10 minutes prior to appointment or enough time to change into your swimsuit and shower

Facility Notes

- Depth is 3 ft to 5 ft
- Ramp entrance to pool
- Aquatic Wheelchair for use, if needed
- Two towels per person provided
- Lockers to store your items during appointment
- Pool is warm therapeutic water temp
