Shirley Chapman Sholom Home East features a unique “neighborhood” approach to nursing focused on personal care by a dedicated care team in a home-like setting.

There are eight “households” or clusters of private\* rooms in the Chapman, four on each of two floors. Every room features a private bathroom and full shower. Like any home, every household has a warm, family kitchen and dining room/lounge which serves as the central gathering spot for its residents and visits by family and friends. Here residents can enjoy a leisurely meal, entertain guests...even bake cookies in the kosher kitchen with visiting grandchildren!

In addition, residents in each household share a neighborhood center on their floor where daily activities - entertainment, games and special events take place - providing an opportunity to get out and about in the “neighborhood” and visit with residents in other households.
