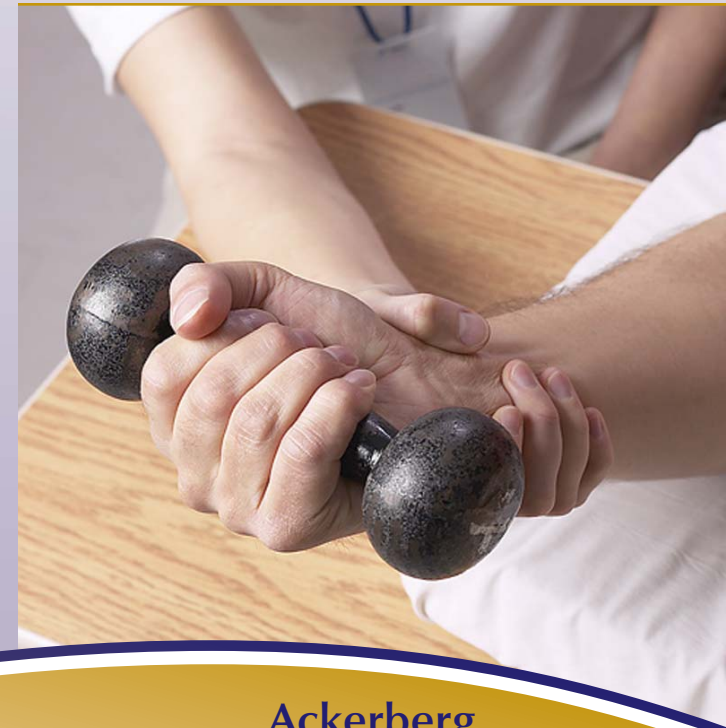

Shalom Home West's comprehensive rehab program is designed for people who have been hospitalized for surgery or other acute illness – and require additional therapy services and rehab nursing care before they return to their own home.

Individualized care is provided with compassion and a friendly therapeutic approach. Staff's goal is to help clients achieve their highest possible level of function and comfort in the shortest time possible.

Every member of the interdisciplinary rehab team – including physical, occupational and speech/language therapists, nurses, registered dietitian, chaplain and social workers – works together to develop a tailored program for care to meet each client's specific needs.

Staff support, encourage and give confidence to each individual as they help them work toward returning home. Plus, clients have the benefit of socializing with others whose medical needs and rehabilitative goals are similar to their own.

## Care Services:

- Admissions accepted from hospitals 24 hours a day/7 days a week
- Rehab Department open 6 days a week - Sunday-Friday
- In-house physical therapy, occupational therapy and speech-language pathology services
- Most insurance plans accepted – including Medicare and Medicaid
- RN on-site 24 hours a day/7 days a week
- Simulated home environment therapy setting with kitchen/laundry appliances plus tub/shower provide opportunity for patients to practice before returning home
- Social services provided by a licensed social worker
- Medical Director consultation
- Specialized dietary services, registered dietician on staff
- Spiritual care
- On-site podiatry, dental, optometry and audiology
- On-site X-ray and lab
- Massage therapy
- Acupuncture and aromatherapy
- Discharge planning for simplified return to home and community
- Linen and personal laundry service
- Daily housekeeping
